The Port Logistics course is designed for port authority executives responsible for developing logistic strategies and operations. Additionally, executives of freight forwarding and logistics companies that specialize in maritime, rail, and road transport, as well as terminal operators and warehouse managers, gain from this course. Officials from government ministries focused on transport, maritime affairs, and customs benefit from this programme.

WHAT
